### Members Meeting Rescheduled

### Anderson Lake Bridge News

The news according to Barry is that when Anderson Lake is drawn down sufficiently at the end of July to permit a full inspection of the bridge supports, the county will inspect and make a report within about three weeks. If all goes well, the repairs will begin and be completed by the end of November. The Board of Directors is also exploring other possibilities of expediting access through Bell Station or Gilroy Hot Springs, but as yet we have no news to report.
