

Henry W. Coe State Park Trail & Camping Map v2023

Overview of Changes

1. Roads/trails added to map
 - a. Braen Canyon Trail (informally known as JDT E-Con)
 - b. Burra Burra Peak Trail (previously just No Name 089)
 - c. Cowgirl Trail (previously just No Name 112)
 - d. Drift Fence Trail
 - e. East Bill's Hill Trail (previously just No Name125)
 - f. Gunsight Trail (previously just No Name 085)
 - g. Heartbreak Trail (sometimes referred to as 4th Trail)
 - h. Kelly Creek Trail
 - i. Mississippi Creek Trail
 - j. Mudd Spring Trail
 - k. Ridge Trail
 - l. Spike Jones Spring Trail - this existing trail was extended southwest across Spike Jones Trail to meet Steer Ridge Road (the extension was know for a short while as Contour Trail)
 - m. Snake Trail
 - n. Sturla Dormida Spring Trail
 - o. View Trail
 - p. Walsh Peak Trail
 - q. Willow Tree Spring Trail
 - r. Winslow's Trail
 - s. Upper Timm Spring Trail
2. Roads/Trails updated to reflect re-routes since 2013
 - a. Center Flats Road
 - b. Dormida Trail
 - c. Mack's Corral Trail
 - d. Timm Trail
3. Cleaned up missing/incorrect mileages for several roads & trails
4. Several trails were originally not labeled due to space constraints; where practical "shoe horned" the name in (E.g., Valley View Trail)
5. Weather stations (including URL) for Orestimba, Headquarters, and Pacheco Camp were added to the map.
6. For public safety reasons, added roads back in the Lakeview and Thomas additions
During emergencies, these roads may be used by official vehicles, but these areas are still closed to the public. These roads are clearly marked on the new map as "emergency use only" with a special color, a red circle with a slash, and text.

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7. Lakes ponds, and springs were updated:
 - a. Several ponds, not previously shown were added to the map
 - b. Troughs that are located some distance from the springs that feed them are now shown on the map.
 - c. A few ponds that no longer exist were removed (Including a rock that had been masquerading as a pond!)
 - d. Lakes and ponds whose shape has significantly changed have been updated (E.g., Paradise Lake)
 - e. Those ponds without names are now labeled with their identifier (E.g., C06) for easy reference.
