Directions to Hunting Hollow: Take Highway 101 to Gilroy (which is about 10 miles south of Morgan Hill and 25 miles south of San Jose). Take the Leavesley Road exit (County Road G9) and head east. After about 1.8 miles, turn left (north) on New Avenue; go a little over half a mile and then turn right (east) on Roop Road. After about 3 miles Roop Road becomes Gilroy Hot Springs Road. The Hunting Hollow entrance is about 3.3 miles past the Coyote Reservoir Road turnoff on Gilroy Hot Springs Road. The distance from 101 to the Hunting Hollow entrance is about 9 miles.
